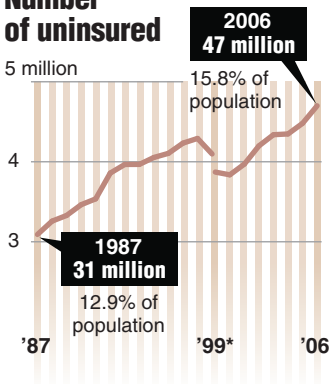


Without health insurance

Almost 12 percent of all U.S. children, or 8.7 million, were uninsured in 2006; percent of uninsured children in various groups:
